

Alton Fire & Rescue Department Standard Operating Guidelines (SOG)

SOG 1.3.8 Permit to Display Red Emergency Light(s) (Reference SOP 1.3.8)

PURPOSE: To insure authorized personnel display red emergency lights.

SCOPE: All Department Personnel

SPECIFICS:

- Department personnel must retain and have available a permit signed by the Fire Chief to display red emergency lighting in or on their personally owned vehicle(s) (POV).
- Red emergency lighting in or on a POV may only be used within the Town of Alton while responding to an emergency incident.

SOP 1.3.8 Permit to Display Red Emergency Light(s)

PURPOSE: Provides for implementation of Emergency Light permits.

SCOPE: All department members.

SPECIFICS:

- Department members shall be permitted to display red emergency lights in or on their POV at the discretion of the Fire Chief and with an issued permit card.
- Said card will be issued by the Department and will be valid for five years from the date of issue.
- The Department member is responsible for notifying the Chief when their card approaches the expiration date for re-issuance.
